2011-2012 Supply List

KINDERGARTEN

- 6 boxes of 24 Crayola crayons (regular size, not large or jumbo)
- 1 spiral notebook, wide-rule, 70-page
- 1 pair Fiskar brand scissors with blunt tip
- 8 glue sticks
- 2 packages of #2 pencils (at least 12 per package)
- 1 box of thin Crayola washable markers (8 basic colors)
- 1 box of thick Crayola washable markers (8 basic colors)
- 1 package of modeling clay – 4 count (no RoseArt please)
- 4 regular size boxes of facial tissues
- 1 package of plastic zipper bags – gallon size
- 1 package of plastic zipper bags – quart size
- 2 packages Expo dry erase markers (4 pack – basic colors)
- 1 package plain white 3” x 5” index cards
- 1 package disinfectant wipes
- 1 bookbag or backpack (large enough for a folder to fit flat (no rolling backpacks))

Girls: 1 box gallon-sized plastic zipper bags and 1 box of bandages

Boys: 1 box of quart-sized plastic zipper bags and 1 package of baby wipes

Please do not label these items with your child’s name. These supplies will be shared by the whole class as community supplies. Please do not send in supply/pencil boxes, Trapper Keepers or pencil sharpeners.

Your child will also need a pair of scissors, pencils, crayons and glue at home to complete homework assignments. Storing these items in a pencil box at home will help your child stay organized and prepared every night.

GRADE 1

- 1 coloring book
- 4 boxes of 24 crayola crayons,
- 1 pair Fiskar (brand) for Kids scissors, blunt tip
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 bookbag or backpack (no wheels – they do not fit in the lockers)
- 6 plain pocket folders – one each in blue, red, yellow, green, orange, purple (plastic folders; no paper)
- 2 package of black ink pens
- 1 package of red ink pens
- 2 package of blue ink pens
- 1 pencil box
- 8 boxes of facial tissue
- 6 packages of plain yellow #2 pencils
- 1 package of 3” x 5” index cards (plain)
- 4 package of thick Crayola washable markers (the 8 basic colors)
- 4 thin dry-erase markers
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer (15 or 12 fluid ounces)
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes
- 4 spiral notebook, 70-page, wide-rule
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener (small; not electric)
- 1 box of plastic zipper bags

PLEASE NOTE – First-grade uses community supplies. ALL supplies will be gathered together and shared. Do not put your child’s name on any supplies. Your child will also need a pair of scissors, pencils, crayons and glue at home to complete homework assignments. Storing these items in a pencil box at home will help your child stay organized and prepared every night.

GRADE 2

- 3 wide-lined, non-perforated, spiral notebooks – one each blue, red and green
- 4 glue sticks
- 2 boxes of 24 crayons
- 1 pack thick Crayola washable markers (8 basic colors)
- 2 boxes of 24 yellow #2 pencils
- 1 pair of scissors
- 3 plain folders with pockets and 3 prongs (no designs please) blue, yellow and red
- 2 packs of black pens
- 4 large boxes of facial tissue
- 1 box gallon-sized plastic zipper bags (if your child is a boy)
- 1 box of sandwich-sized plastic zipper bags (if your child is a girl)
- 1 package of 3" x 5" index cards (lined)
- 1 yellow highlighter
- 1 package of thin black dry-erase markers
- 1 composition notebook (9 ¾ x 7 ½)
- 1 bookbag or backpack (no wheels – they do not fit in the lockers)
- 1 pack wide-ruled, loose-leaf paper
- 1 pack Post-It notes
- 1 pencil box
- 1 package of blue pens (if your student is a boy)
- 1 package of red pens (if your student is a girl)
- 1 12 oz bottle hand sanitizer (if your student is a girl)
- 1 package of disinfectant wipes (if your student is a boy)

PLEASE NOTE – Second-grade uses community supplies. ALL supplies will be gathered together and shared, so do not put your child's name on any supplies. Please do not send supply boxes or trapper keepers.

Grade 3

- 5 wide-ruled spiral notebooks
- 3 composition books
- 1 pack of wide-ruled loose-leaf paper
- 1 school box
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 ruler with both metric and standard measures
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 liquid glue
- 5 sturdy folders with pockets and prongs (plain, please – no designs)
- 3 boxes of #2 wood pencils (no mechanical pencils)
- 1 eraser
- 1 box of crayons (24 count or less)
- 1 box 8–10 markers (any brand)
- 4 boxes of facial tissues
- 1 package of blue or black pens
- 2 red pens
- 2 green pens
- 1 pencil sharpener
- 1 box of sandwich- sized plastic zipper bags (if your child is a girl)
- 1 box gallon-sized plastic zipper bags (if your child is a boy)

Please do not label any supplies. Please be prepared to replenish supplies at mid-year.

Grade 4

- 1 1" to 1 ½" binder
- 1 composition notebook
- 4 spiral notebooks
- 5 folders – (three pronged)
- 3 boxes of facial tissues
- Girls: 1 box of sandwich-sized plastic zipper baggies
- Boys: 1 box of gallon-sized plastic zipper baggies
- 1 box of (10 or 12 count) washable markers **and/or** colored pencils
- 3 packages of loose- leaf paper
- 1 pack of red, blue, **or** black pens. (2-3 count)
- 1 bottle of liquid glue (**no glue sticks please!**)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 box of crayons (24 count)
- 1 pencil box or pouch
- 1 STURDY folder (to be used as their homework folder)
- 1 container of disinfectant wipes
- 1 ruler (with centimeter and inch marks)

No wheeled bookbags, please. The lockers are too narrow.

Grade 5

- 6 single-subject spiral notebooks (at least 70 pages)
- 4 packs of wide-rule notebook paper
- 3 boxes of family size facial tissues
- 1 box #2 pencils
- 1 pack of black pens
- 1 pack of black pens
- 1 pack of black pens
- 3 folders with pockets (no trapper keepers)
- 1 pack of colored pencils
- 3 glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 pencil pouch
- 1 box plastic zipper bags, gallon-sized (if student is a boy) and quart-sized (if student is a girl)

Students should NOT BRING lotion, make-up, white-out, collectibles, gum/candy, unnecessary money or toys. Please do not label these items with your child's name. These supplies will be shared by the whole class as community supplies. Please do not send in supply/pencil boxes, Trapper Keepers, or pencil sharpeners. Supplies will be collected at our Back to School Barbeque and on the first day of school.

Your child will also need a pair of scissors, pencils, crayons and glue at home to complete homework assignments. Storing these items in a pencil box at home will help your child stay organized and prepared every night.
