**Second Grade**

- 1 Large container sanitizing wipes
- 2 Rolls paper towels
- 4 Wide-rule, spiral-bound notebooks (1 each - red, blue, green, yellow)
- 4 Pocket folders (1 ea - red, blue, green, yellow)
- 2 Boxes of crayons (no larger than 24-count)
- 2 Black/white composition notebooks
- 2 Boxes of 24-count #2 pencils -- sharpen ALL at home
- 1 Set of colored pencils
- 1 Pair of Fiskar scissors
- 20 White glue sticks
- 4 Large erasers & a pack of pencil-top erasers
- 3 LARGE boxes facial tissue
- 1 Package **THIN** Crayola Markers for Art Room
- 1 Package of small post-it notes (2" x 2")
- 1 Package of large post-it notes (3" x 3")
- 1 Large container of baby wipes for hands
- 2 Dry erase markers (for their personal dry erase board)
- 1 Dry-erase board eraser or a square of felt (for their personal dry erase board)

### Third Grade

Please label all supplies by the first day of school.

- 1 pack **wide-rule** loose-leaf paper
- 1 pkg. large pink or white erasers
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- Scissors
- 2 bottles **liquid glue** and 4 **glue sticks** (more as needed)
- 3 lg. boxes facial tissue (more in January)
- Centimeter/inch wooden ruler
- 1 pkg. 8-10 count washable markers
- 24-count #2 lead plain yellow pencils, **sharpened at home** (more as needed)
- Colored pencils
- 4 spiral **wide-rule** notebooks with at least 70 pages (red, yellow, green, blue)
- zipper bags (girls: quart-size, boys: gallon-size)
- 4 folders (large, sturdy kind-not plastic)
- 2 rolls paper towels
- 1 plastic shoe box with a removable lid – standard-size, 6 qt. (not oversized)
- Heavy-duty **1 1/2" binder** with **7 plastic pocket dividers** as labeled:  
(Please label dividers: Reading, Language Arts, Spelling, Math, Science, Social Studies, Handwriting)
- Heavy-duty **1" binder** with **5 plastic pocket dividers** as labeled:  
(Please label dividers: Topic List, Spelling/Vocabulary, 6SixTraits, Writing on Hold, Writing in Progress)
- 1 container sanitizing wipes
- 1 zipper pouch for binder (3-hole punched)
- 2 composition notebooks (hard, marbled cover – not spiral)
- 1 pkg. dry erase markers
- \$4.50 for a Planner
- **Girls:** 1 Box sandwich or snack-size zipper bags for Art Room
- **Boys:** 1 Box gallon-size zipper bag for Art Room

#### **Do Not Send:**

Stapler, mechanical pencils, zipper binders, Trapper Keepers

#### **Note:**

Students should label and place supplies in a shoe box before coming to school. Supplies may need to be removed from packages in order to fit in the box. Many supplies will need to be replenished in January.

- 2 boxes facial tissue
- 6 sturdy pocket folders with holes
- 7 composition notebooks
- Boys: sanitizing wipes, gallon-size zipper bags
- Girls: sanitizing wipes, quart-size zipper bags
- 1 Box facial tissue for Art Room
- Plastic shoe box
- 1-1/2" Binder
- \$3.50 for a Planner

Supplies will need to be replenished throughout the year. Please keep that in mind as you purchase supplies.
